This source release contains the source code used to build PGP 8.0 for Windows.

Requirements:

The following packages are needed to build PGP 8.0 for Windows:

1. Microsoft Visual C++ 6.0
Available from most software resellers
2. Microsoft Visual Studio 6.0 Service Pack 5

3. Microsoft Platform SDK

Before building, the following environment variables should be set:

```
BASEDIR=C:\path\for\NT4\DDK
98DDKROOT=C:\path\for\98\DDK
NT4DDKROOT=C:\path\for\NT4\DDK
NT5DDKROOT=C:\path\for\Win2K+XP\DDK
```

Additionally, the Directories tab located in Microsoft Visual Studio's Options dialog (accessed from the Tools->Options... menu) must be updated such that the following directories are listed in their respective section:

Include files:
  C:\path\for\PlatformSDK\include
  C:\path\for\Win2K+XP\DDK\inc
  C:\path\for\NT4\DDK\inc
  C:\path\for\98\DDK\inc

Library files:
  C:\path\for\PlatformSDK\lib
  C:\path\for\Win2K+XP\DDK\lib
  C:\path\for\NT4\DDK\lib
  C:\path\for\98\DDK\lib
  C:\path\for\LotusNotesSDK\lib\mswin32

Source files:
  C:\path\for\PlatformSDK\src
  C:\path\for\Win2K+XP\DDK\src
  C:\path\for\NT4\DDK\src
  C:\path\for\98\DDK\src
```

Editing: For proper reading of these source files, it is recommended that you use a tab width of 4 in your editor.
