

PGP 8.0 Source Code

This source release contains the source code used to build PGP 8.0 for Mac OS X.

Requirements: Mac OS X 10.2.2 with August 2002 Developer Tools

Note that system header files and compiler semantics tend to change from release to release of Apple's Developer Tools and thus you may experience problems if you do not use exactly the configuration required here. A common confusion users experience is caused by the installation of the QuickTime 6.0.2 updater which modifies system libraries without synchronizing with the Developer Tools and thus causes a litany of warnings when compiling. To alleviate pre-compiled header problems, issue the command "sudo fixPrecomps -force" in the Terminal application.

Editing: For proper reading of these source files, it is recommended that you activate the "Editor uses tabs" feature of *Project Builder*, and set the Tab Width to 4.

Building: To build this source code, follow these steps:

1. Open clients2/console/osx/PGP.pbproj in *Project Builder*
2. Select the *Build All* target
3. Select *Build* from the *Build* menu
4. Wait for the build to complete
5. The resulting executable will be found in the *build* directory next to the project file.
